IT IS ORDERED:

- 1. The Court "So Orders" all the Agreement's terms which are incorporated herein. Capitalized terms used in this Order have the same meaning as set forth in the Agreement, unless defined otherwise.
 - 2. The Court certifies the Class for settlement purposes.
 - 3. The Court appoints Shavitz Law Group, P.A. as Class Counsel.
- 4. The Courts appoints RG/2 Claims Administration LLC as the Settlement Claims Administrator and approves the Settlement Claims Administrator's fees and costs to be paid separately by Defendant in addition to the Settlement Fund.
 - 5. The Court approves the Service Awards set forth in the Agreement.

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6. The Court approves Plaintiffs' request for attorneys' fees of one-third of the

of the date, time, and location of the hearing, and instruct the Settlement Claims Administrator to

circulate notice of the hearing date, time and location to all authorized Claimants, via email. In

the absence of any objections that include a request to be heard, this Order shall serve as the Final

Order.

9. The Court adopts the settlement procedures and timeline set forth in the Agreement.

10. The parties shall abide by the terms of the Agreement and Release.

11. The Court retains jurisdiction over this Litigation to enforce the Agreement.
